WHAT'S INVOLVED?

DEADLINE: 14TH MAY 2021

Submit a short (up to 1 page) declaration of **interest**, including the context of your practice or research, along with your data





DEADLINE: 4TH JUNE 2021

Once accepted, prepare and submit a short video or audio abstract of up to 5 minutes to briefly introduce your practice or research.

These will be available to participants before the conference, and more broadly afterwards. Written abstracts are not required.



ON 7TH/8TH JULY 2021

Design and deliver a micropresentation (5-7 slides) including a question prompt slide for participants.

You will have **5 minutes** to deliver your presentation and **10** minutes for follow-up questions and discussion.
